Thank you to everyone who got involved by entering photos which are currently on display at the Leisure Centre. Pop down and have a look!



Many Killamarsh residents may not appreciate the range and diversity of Voluntary and Community Groups which meet in the Leisure Centre. One such is the Killamarsh Kurling Club, which meets every Tuesday 1.00pm-3.00pm throughout the year.

At present the group has about 23 members, whose ages range from Kai, 7 years to Ina, 91 years. In addition, staff from the Nethermoor Care Home take around 6 residents every week to join in the fun. The group encourages residents to take part in local competitions using a specially made ramp if needed, and awards trophies to the best scoring players. Vera (Pictured) is the Champion and winner of three trophies.

Organisers Ken and Kevin are hoping to hold an inter club competition in November, linking with local groups based in Eckington and Mosborough.

In addition to the Kurling, the group organises a few social events every year, Pie and Pea suppers and Christmas Dinner proving popular with the members. A raffle is held every week which helps with funds for equipment, extras and to keep the cost of participation to a very modest £2.00 per week.

This group really has something for everyone; able or less able, players can sit or stand. Everyone enjoys the social element and joins in with the friendly banter.

Cameron played for the Junior Blades as a 6 year old in a season which saw the team win every match.

As a 7 year-old Cameron was scouted by Manchester United and Sheffield United and trained with both clubs. At the age of 9 he signed a contract with Sheffield United and played with them until he was 17.

Cameron attended Westfield Sports College whilst training on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons with SUFC.

Bradford City signed Cameron on a professional contract in March of this year and he made his home debut on May 1st in a 1-1 draw against Walsall.

KILLAMARSH PARISH COUNCIL - JOINT LITTER AWARENESS PROJECT 2017/18

In September 2017 the three Primary schools in Killamarsh were contacted with a view to launching a Litter Awareness Project.

The Parish Council has been increasingly concerned at the volume of litter throughout Killamarsh and in particular in amenity areas such as parks and green spaces. The associated hazards to children, animals and wildlife, and the cost to the public and to the environment are well known yet litter continues to increase. The Council has been looking for new and innovative ways of tackling this ongoing problem and agreed to support the promotion of litter awareness amongst our Primary school aged children.

Primary Schools in Killamarsh were offered a small grant from **Derbyshire County Council, Community Leadership Fund** via local Member **Diane Charles** towards materials to start a project to raise awareness with the children. Participation in the project was invited to take any form but to produce a tangible outcome,

something produced by the children to be shared with the whole community.

In addition, Cllr Lilian Robinson liaised with **NEDDC** Environmental Enforcement Team Leader, Tommy Rush, and with two of his staff visited the schools during May to deliver the Keep Britain Tidy initiative.

The schools all enthusiastically integrated the work into their ongoing activities, and actively involved the pupils in developing ideas. All three schools took a different approach and were invited to bring their work to the Leisure centre for judging at the end of the Summer term 2018.


